

## Care following stitches

- The approximate time needed for your wound to heal is 1 week.
- Avoid straining the affected area to prevent the wound from opening.
- The wound must be cured every 2 or 3 days as follows:
- 1. Wash your hands with soap and water before the cure.
- 2. Carefully remove the dressing.
- 3. Clean the wound with saline solution.
- 4. Thoroughly dry the wound with clean gauze or a hairdryer.
- 5. Apply iodized povidone (betadine) to the wound.



• The stitches are removed after approximately 1 week by your health center nurse (Do not forget to make a prior appointment).

## Consult your doctor if:

1. You have a temperature



- 2. The temperature, pain in or reddening of the affected area increases.
- 3. The wound opens.



4. There is discharge.
